Complete Growth Medium

Minium essential Medium Eagle with 2 mM L-glutamine and Earle's BSS adjusted to contain 1.5 g/L sodium bicarbonate, 0.1 mM non-essential amino acids, and 1.0 mM sodium pyruvate and supplemented with 2 mM L-glutamine, 1.32 g/L sodium chloride, 0.1 mM non-essential amino acids and 10% heat-inactivated fetal bovine serum.

SAFETY PRECAUTION

ATCC highly recommends that protective gloves and clothing always be used and a full face mask always be worn when handling frozen vials. It is important to note that some vials leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vessel exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris.

Unpacking & Storage Instructions

1. Check all containers for leakage or breakage.
2. Remove the frozen cells from the dry ice packaging and immediately place the cells at a temperature below -130°C, preferably in liquid nitrogen vapor, until ready for use.

Handling Procedure for Frozen Cells

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To insure the highest level of viability, thaw the vial and initiate the culture as soon as possible upon receipt. If upon arrival, continued storage of the frozen culture is necessary, it should be stored in liquid nitrogen vapor phase and not at -70°C. Storage at -70°C will result in loss of viability.

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Subculturing Procedure

Protocol: Remove the spent medium, rinse flask with fresh 0.25% trypsin, 0.03% EDTA and remove trypsin. Add an additional 1 to 2 ml of trypsin solution, and allow the flask to sit at room temperature until the cells detach. Add fresh culture medium, aspirate and dispense into new culture flasks.

The cells should be grown in PRIMARIA flasks (Falcon Nos. 3813 or 3824)

Subcultivation Ratio: A subcultivation ratio of 1:2 to 1:3 is recommended

Medium Renewal: Every 2 to 3 days

Complete growth medium described above supplemented with 5% (v/v) DMSO.
