Handling Procedures

Centrifuge tube prior to opening to prevent loss of pelleted material

- 1. Rehydrate contents of vial with molecular grade H_2O .
- 2. Place vial at 37°C for 1 hour or at 2°C to 8°C overnight.
- 3. For more complete rehydration and to fully recover DNA, incubate the sample overnight at 4°C while rocking; then incubate for 1 hour at 65°C. Resuspending the dried DNA in \ge 250 µL may give better results.

Notes

Genomic DNA is appropriate for PCR and other molecular biology applications.
