Growth Conditions

Medium:

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ATCC Medium 35: Bordet Gengou Agar/Broth Medium

Temperature: 37°C

Atmosphere: Aerobic

Handling Procedures

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
 2. Using a single tube of #35 broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
 3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
 4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #35 agar slant and/or plate.
 5. Incubate all tubes and plate at 37°C for 72 to 96 hours.
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Notes

It may be beneficial to establish growth in a tube of broth for 48 hours before transferring to solid medium. Best growth is obtained with the use of fresh media.
