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ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always used when handling vials. For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submerged in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submerged in liquid nitrogen.

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## Growth Conditions

**Medium:**

ATCC Medium 3: Nutrient agar or nutrient broth

ATCC Medium 2546: Mineral Medium pH 7.25

**Temperature:** 30°C

**Atmosphere:** Aerobic; Anaerobic

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## Handling Procedures

1. Open vial according to enclosed instructions.
2. Using a single tube of #3 broth (5 to 6 mL), withdraw approximately 0.5 to 1.0 mL with a Pasteur or 1.0 mL pipette. Rehydrate the entire pellet.
3. Aseptically transfer this aliquot back into the broth tube. Mix well.
4. Use several drops of the suspension to inoculate a #3 agar slants and/or plate.

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5. Incubate the tubes and plate at 30°C for 48 to 96 hours.

\*When testing for the utilization of chlorate, it must be under anaerobic conditions.

Substrate utilization:

1. Add the electron donor (final concentration of 10 mM) and acceptor (final concentration of 10 mM) to ATCC Medium #2546.
2. Exchange gas in head space for 80% N<sub>2</sub> - 20% CO<sub>2</sub> or 100% N<sub>2</sub>.
3. Reduce the medium with the addition of cysteine (0.1 mL per 10 mL of medium, stock concentration of 3%). Let the medium sit at room temperature for a minimum of 30 minutes.
4. Inoculate the medium with 0.5 mL of actively growing culture (use #3 broth culture).

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## Notes

\*When testing for the utilization of chlorate, it must be under anaerobic conditions.
