



# Rodent protoparvovirus 1

VR-1346™

## Description

Rodent protoparvovirus 1 strain Prototype (p) is propagated in A9 cells (ATCC CCL-1.4). This strain was plaque-purified from Minute virus of mice strain Crawford and deposited by Yale University School of Medicine.

**Strain designation:** Prototype (p)

**Common name:** Minute virus of mice

**Deposited As:** Minute virus of mice

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## Storage Conditions

**Product format:** Frozen

**Storage conditions:** -70°C or colder

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## Intended Use

This product is intended for laboratory research use only. It is not intended for any animal or human therapeutic use, any human or animal consumption, or any diagnostic use.

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## BSL 2

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ATCC highly recommends that appropriate personal protective equipment is always used when handling vials. For cultures that require storage in liquid nitrogen, it is important to note that some vials may leak when submersed in liquid nitrogen and will slowly fill with liquid nitrogen. Upon thawing, the conversion of the liquid nitrogen back to its gas phase may result in the vial exploding or blowing off its cap with dangerous force creating flying debris. Unless necessary, ATCC recommends that these cultures be stored in the vapor phase of liquid nitrogen rather than submersed in liquid nitrogen.

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## Growth Conditions

**Host:** A9 (APRT and HPRT negative derivative of Strain L) (ATCC CCL-1.4)

**Effects:** cell enlargement; cell rounding; CPE

**Complete medium:**

DMEM (ATCC 30-2002) + FBS (ATCC 30-2020)

**Temperature:** 37°C

**Atmosphere:** 95% Air, 5% CO<sub>2</sub>

**Recommendations for infection:** Plate cells 24 hours prior to infection and infect when cultures are 60-80% confluent. Remove medium and inoculate with a small volume of virus (e.g. 1 mL per 25 cm<sup>2</sup>) diluted to provide an optimal MOI (e.g. 0.1). Adsorb 1-2 hours at 37°C in a humidified 5% CO<sub>2</sub> atmosphere, rocking every 15-20 minutes to redistribute inoculum. End adsorption by adding virus growth medium.

**Incubation:** 2-3 days
